Dear Mr. Delsol and Mr. Emmerichs:

We received and appreciated the letter of 3/2/2006 from Mr. Emmerichs. Unfortunately, it contained no new information for the community and mostly repeated the details of the inadequate BAAQMD settlement agreement. The letter failed answer our demand to provide a detailed plan and timeline coupled with specific goals for eliminating the pollution and nuisance problems that Pacific Steel Casting (PSC) continues to create.

The community expects more from PSC. It expects PSC to produce no harmful emission and no odor problems. CleanAirCoalition.net (CAC) expects you to create and implement a plan that will get rid of these problems once and for all. CAC requests that PSC provide a detailed plan and timeline to achieve the following goals:

1. A specific plan for the elimination of toxic air emissions; particulate emissions, including heavy metals; and odor complaints;
2. Elimination of all toxic chemicals in the production process, including the replacement of existing organic binders with non-toxic ones;
3. Funding and implementing health monitoring for workers and community members; air monitoring conducted by experts acceptable to CAC consistent with protocols approved by CAC;
4. Independent auditing and monitoring of PSC's operations by CAC selected environmental engineers and other experts;
5. Accountability and public dissemination of all data and pertinent record keeping - for all incinerator data, volume of production, raw materials used, as well as the health data, air quality data, and compliance data;

We request the courtesy of a response within 21 days. Thank you for your prompt attention to this important matter.
